

Physical or mental impairment has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on the persons' ability to carry out normal day-to-day activities. Disabilities could be congenital or acquired. In some instances, preventable. Visual impairment and blindness are around 4.9% i.e. 13 million people are affected. A study revealed 4.8% of the country's total population have a hearing disability. The prevalence of mental disorders in Pakistan is as high as 10%, affecting approximately 25 million Pakistanis. So, these conditions alone affect 20% of our population. The statistics of acquired brain injury and the physical disabilities due to accidental trauma are also very high. Early diagnosis, importance of preventive measures like habit of listening at low volume, avoiding loud, noisy activities and places. Avoiding ototoxic medications.

The importance of physiotherapy in the patients with acquired physical disabilities. Rehabilitation centres and their easy accessibility is essential for our healthcare system.

Early diagnosis and management of stroke can also prevent a lot of disabilities and lives.

Multidisciplinary approach and a close liaison between Neonatology and Obstetrics can help in early diagnosis and prevention of a lot of avoidable disabilities in children.

Being the part of an injury prone society, our trauma and emergency care teams are overburdened by the work load. Lack of awareness of preventive measures result in injuries – critical injuries and our trauma care professionals have to manage those severely injured patients. It's a serious issue and it has to be handled at different levels to prevent accidents and reduce disabilities and save lives due to such emergencies. Government's role in rapid first aid and basic trauma life support, advanced trauma life support, transfer to trauma centres and definitive care and treatment. Integration of all the resources especially telemedicine as well as planning to create integrated and connected trauma care facilities which will provide timely treatment to the victims. Current human resource needs as well as the facilities of trauma centres were discussed.
Pre hospital care & swift transfer of injured patients to the trauma centres; current status & future plans at national level were discussed along with transfer of victims to definitive treatment within the golden hour after the injury. The management of accidents and disasters. SERS and SIEHS resourcefulness and preparedness to handle such situations and their achievements since their inception and the future plans were discussed.

Healthy outcome of pregnancies are to be ensured through prenatal, perinatal & postnatal maternal healthcare.

Pakistan has a neonatal mortality rate (NMR) of 41 deaths per 1000 live births, one of the highest in the world, and an under-5 child mortality rate (U5MR) of 67 deaths per 1000 live births. High infant and maternal mortality rate in Pakistan are attributed to unsafe delivery practices, according to the Pakistan Medical Association. In rural areas where unhygienic practices and inexperienced midwives make nonhospital deliveries a danger, it can become a hazard to both the mother and the child. Neonatology and Paediatric segment need special attention to improve the quality of care so that the positive and healthy outcome of pregnancies are ensured and the U5MR comes down. The resourcefulness of Sindh/National Institute of Child Health must be uplifted. Current human resource needs as well as the facilities of NICH along with the shortfalls will be highlighted. Prenatal, perinatal and postnatal maternal healthcare are the key issues, Literacy, rural urban facilities disparity, early marriages, multiple pregnancies with low spacing and nutrition are the major problems. Proper examination of the neonates, identification of developmental abnormalities and their management, liaison with good international teaching hospitals and regular trainings, CPDs, CMEs can help in the improvement of quality of care and clinical outcome.

Noncommunicable diseases (NCDs), are the leading cause of death. Heart disease, cancer, chronic respiratory disease, and diabetes, are the leading cause of death worldwide and represent an emerging global health threat. Deaths from NCDs now exceed all communicable disease deaths combined. Educating the community and increasing the awareness would definitely decrease their incidence and as a result will lower the healthcare spending and burden. Vascular health. Cardiovascular diseases (CVD) are expensive and difficult to treat, devastate the families. Let's change our lives to have better health. Neurovascular diseases, especially stroke & resulting disabilities are rising, these diseases overwhelm the families. Mass awareness programs about the prevention as well as recognizing this early will definitely prevent the disease. 26.7% of adults in Pakistan are affected by diabetes i.e. over 33 million. Management of disease & its complications are major issues. CVDs, CKDs, stroke, vision, hearing, and mental health issues can occur due to diabetes. NCD prevalence could be significantly reduced by adopting a healthy lifestyle. According to the WHO 80% of heart diseases, strokes and T2DM could be prevented or delayed by lifestyle changes. Rampant and injudicious usage of antibacterial agents has to be stopped.

Pakistan has a poverty rate of 30–40%, which is a significant factor that results in a high prevalence of infectious diseases. Bad hygiene and low socioeconomic conditions predispose to a lot of infections. The treatment is being done by rampant and injudicious usage of antibacterial agents, which is aggravating certain management issues. Besides, malaria, dengue, diarrheal diseases, typhoid & TB are also rampant. Viral infections like hepatitis B and C, HIV & influenza are also alarmingly high. We have to act and advocate a strategy to handle this healthcare dilemma. URTI & LRTI are very high. CMEs for the primary care physicians to improve their diagnostic skills as well as their prescription habits. Selection of antibiotics and their correct posology is imperative in improving the healthcare. According to the WHO report, Pakistan bears the second-largest burden of hepatitis C, with a nationwide prevalence of 4.8%. There are estimated 7-9 million carriers of hepatitis B virus (HBV) with a carrier rate of 3-5%. National hepatitis registry in Pakistan is a dire need. 40% women & 13% men will have symptoms of a Urinary tract infection (UTI) during their lifetime. Public education on causes of disease transmission and control strategies is required. Menstrual hygiene management is a significant problem, particularly in low-income communities. According to UNICEF, 44% females do not have access to basic menstrual hygiene facilities.
